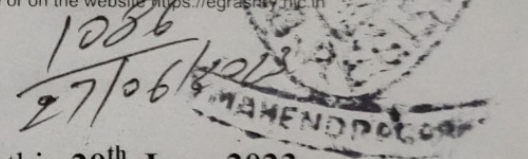

Further the following persons have at the request of the settler agreed to act as the trustees and hereinafter jointly called the LIFE MEMBER TRUSTEES (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include their successors in office)

A. **Vinod Kumar Yadav S/o Daya Nand Yadav**, aged about 46 years, resident of village **Paiga** tehsil and district **Mahendergarh, Haryana- 123029.**

B. **Yashwin S/o Vinod Kumar Yadav**, resident of village **Paiga** tehsil and district **Mahendergarh, Haryana- 123029.**

C. **Indravati W/o Daya Nand Yadav**, resident of village **Paiga** tehsil and district **Mahendergarh, Haryana- 123029**

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

NAME

1. The name of the trust shall be "**Late Sh. Kishori Lal Educational Trust**".

HEAD OFFICE

2. The head office of the trust shall be at "**Old Narnaul Road opp. Model Sanskriti School Play Ground Mohlla Sainipura Town**".

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"Mahendergarh" Tehsil & Distt. Mahendergarh, Haryana-123029 or such other place as may be found suitable from time to time. The trust shall function from any other place(s) also as may be decided upon by the time being trustees and members by way of resolution or otherwise.

OBJECTS

3. The objects for which the Trust is founded are as follows:

A. To sponsor, take over, organize, establish, construct maintain and promote the quality teaching and research and for the advancement of knowledge in District Mahendergarh or the Surroundings areas and other places in India and manage or run the educational institutions or the educational institutions promoting the quality teaching and research, health institutions, school, collages, Education collages, academic, laboratories and library, Medical Collages, Pharmacy collages, Paramedical Collages, Nursing Collages, Veterinary Education, Homeopathy Education, Ayurvedic Education, Yoga Education, Physiotherapy Education, Engineering & Technical Education, Management Education, Research Institutions.

B. To promote, spread and impart all aspects of the quality teaching and research etc.

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- C. To establish School, College, educational institution or University under the laws of the land, institutions of higher learning offering innovative and job oriented courses with special emphasis on research and development in the fields of technical education, health sciences including medical/para medical/dental education, law, science and technology etc. at par with the best in India and abroad.
- D. To provide for instruction and training in such branches of learning as it may deem fit.
- E. To provide for research, innovation and for the advancement of and dissemination' of knowledge through establishing campuses, print media, electronic media, digital media, internet media, radio etc.
- F. To undertake extra moral studies, extension programmes and field outreach activities to contribute to the development of society.
- G. To establish, manage, control, supervise, run, lease out Training / Coaching Centers, Schools, Colleges etc. for imparting education in various disciplines, but primarily for Technical Education, Medical Education, Dental Education, Para-medical Colleges/ Diploma/undergraduate/postgraduate courses on various fields such as Ayurvedic, Homoeopathy,

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Naturopathy, Pharmacy nursing, laboratory Radio diagnosis, Occupational therapy, Dietician, Acupuncture /Acupressure therapy, Management courses and all other such disciplines and prescribed courses by the state govt. and central govt., public limited companies and foreign Universities/ Institutions from time to time to help the Industrial and economical developments of the country.

- H. To provide necessary facilities or to contribute to educational and scientific research development in any place as the trust finds deemed fit.
- I. And other Non Government Organization works and such other institutions for education in any field of studies.
- J. To promote research in arts, science, and humanities and also to hold seminars, arrange lectures, conferences, exhibitions, or other meetings or events for the dissemination of knowledge and advancement of culture and fine arts.
- K. To give financial help, aid, scholarships, prizes, stipend, loans grant to any other person, society, trust institutions or authority for the promotion of education, Literature, sciences, humanities, fine arts, crafts, sports and cultural activities.

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- L. To engage in any other activity related to and for the advancement of education, not specified here above, which is not consistent with the object of the trust being promotion of Education.
- M. To run, maintain or assist any medical institution, nursing home or Yog or Prakrtik Chikitsa clinic or the grant assistance to the needy and indigent person for meeting the cost of medical treatment.
- N. To give financial or other assistance in kind by way of distribution of books, notebooks, clothes, uniforms, or meals for the poor and indigent.
- O. To print , publish, purchase, sell, circulate, distribute or exhibit either free or for a price - books, periodicals, journals, booklets, bulletins, calendars, message-cards, other literature, films, documentaries, records, paintings and photographs which will assist or promote the objects of the Trust.
- P. To acquire and maintain the movables and immovable properties for achieving the objects of the trust.
- Q. To honor and confer title on eminent personality in the field of education/ teaching and research etc.,

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R. To purchase, sell or otherwise distribute materials and services in the furtherance of the objectives of the Trust.

S. To advance any other objects of general public utility.

- if any of the above objects are found to be inconsistent with the objects of a public charitable institution under Section 11 or any other section of the income tax act, 1961 or any other direct tax law or any other law applicable to trusts as now enacted or as may be treated as so modified to accord with such lower amended law so that any concessions, privileges, conditions or regulations available to and applicable to such public charitable institutions will be available to this trust as well so that this trust will continue to retain its character as a public charitable institutions without profit motive with public character within the meaning of all such laws.
- All the objects and activities of the trust will be confined to India, and will be carried on without profit motive and without any distinction on account of caste, creed, color or religion.

BENEFICIARIES

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4. The Trust is established for the benefit for the humanity, irrespective of or without discrimination of caste, case, religion, creed or sex.

And

All the objects and activities of the trust shall be carried out anywhere in India, and will be carried on without profit motive and without any distinction on account of caste, creed, color or religion, sex etc.

Board of Trustees/Trustees

5. Board of Trustees/trustees:-

The number of trustees shall not be less than three trustees. Collectively they will be known as the "BOARD OF TRUSTEES" or the BOARD provided that the following shall constitute the first board of trustees:-

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- A. The Trustees named hereinabove shall be called the founder Trustee.
- B. The board of Trustees shall have the power to appoint /Reappoint one or more persons as trustees. The term of office of the appointed Trustees who are not the first trustee shall be initially for one year from the date of their acceptance in writings, unless the period for which they shall so act as Trustees is stipulated at the time of their appointment by the resolution of the board of trustees appointing them as trustees, or if such trustee is removed from the board of trustees, as defined hereinafter. The appointed trustee shall be eligible for reappointment on retirement.
- C. The proceedings of the Board of Trustees shall not in any way be invalidated due to any post or posts remaining vacant. During the time when a vacancy is yet to be filled up, the remaining Trustees shall act as **"Full Board"**, subject to the presence of Quorum in the meetings. Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees or illegality in the

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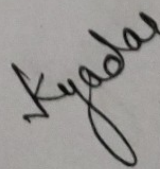
appointment of Trustees or their proceedings shall not invalidate any prior act or decision of the Board.

- D. No person shall be eligible to be appointed as a trustee under clause 5(B) and such as trustee (as appointed under clause 5(B) shall cease to hold office if, He/She is removed from the board of trustees, subject to the motion of removable having been supported by at least one founder Trustee.
- E. That the Maximum Number of trustees can be 7, which can be increase by a special resolution and for that special resolution it shall be necessary or the mandatory that minimum $2/3^{\text{rd}}$ trustees of the total numbers of the trustees at the time being accept and sign the resolution proposed so.
- F. The trustee of this trust, **Sh. Vinod Kumar Yadav** shall be the **First Chairperson/Patron and the Managing Trustee** of the Trust and **Sh. Yashwin** shall be the first **Secretary**.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD

6. The Board shall perform his duties as follows:-

- A. The board shall meet as often as it is necessary to transact the business relating to the trust, provided that they shall meet at least once in every three months.



- B. One half of the Board of Trustees shall constitute the QUORUM for the Board of Trustees meetings
- C. A minute's book shall be maintained for recording the resolutions passed at the board meeting.
- D. Every trustee present at the meeting shall sign his/her name in the minute book
- E. All decisions shall be carried out by the majority decision of the Board but in the event of equality of votes, the Chairman presiding over the meeting shall have a casting vote.
- F. The board shall have the power appoint any employee from any committee for the attainment of the objects of the trust and also delegate any of its power to any of trust or to employees or committees to the extent it considers necessary or expedient.
- G. In any case if it is not possible for the trustee to be physically present at the meeting, the proceedings can be taken up via electronic media like video conferencing, web conferencing, telephonically or any mode of communication which may be found suitable considering the exigencies of the situation.

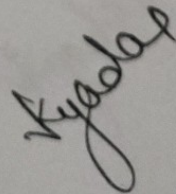
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- H. The meeting of Board of Trustees shall be convened by the Managing Trustee. In his absence, the Managing Trustee may authorize to any other Trust member to convene such meetings. Any member of the Board of the Trustees can call for a meeting.
- I. Any resolution in writing signed by all the Trustees by circulation shall have equal force as though it has been passed at a meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- J. The meeting of the Board shall be convened after giving at least a week's notice unless all the Trustees agree to accept a shorter notice.
- K. The Board of Trustees may invite other persons interested in the objects and functioning of the Trust to attend the meetings of the Board, but they shall not be entitled vote in the meetings of the Board.

TRUST ADMINISTRATION AND POWER TO THE BOARD

7. The Board of Trustees shall have power:

- A. To administer the Trust, its properties and affairs and do all the things which will fulfill the performance of the objects for which the Trust is established and for this purpose the



Board can apply the whole or any part of the Trust property towards the payment of the expenses of the Trust.

- B. To see that the income and the properties of the Trust is solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust.
- C. To open one or more bank accounts and operate the same or provide for operation of the said accounts by any two among them authorized on their behalf.
- D. To invest the Trust funds in the manner not prohibited by any provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- E. To buy, sell, mortgage, grant, lease, hire or otherwise alienate all or any of the properties of the Trust in its discretion for adequate consideration, so however any sale or alienation of immovable properties of the trust can be done only after obtaining the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
- F. To execute power of attorney or powers of attorney to any person for the purpose of executing, administering or managing the whole or any part of the Trust for the purpose of all or some among the objects of the Trust.
- G. To borrow money with or without security and to repay the same.

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- H. To receive, collect and enforce recovery of all monies due or payable to the Trust and grant receipts and discharges therefore.
- I. To settle, compromise or compound any disputes or refer the same to arbitration or litigation.
- J. To receive voluntary contributions from any person or persons, any organization, association, trust and NGO from India or outside, after complying with the statutory formalities, by way of donation, gifts or in any other manner and to hold the same upon Trust for the objects set forth herein.
- K. To appoint, suspend, dismiss or otherwise deal with the staff required for the administration of the Trust, to frame rules relating to their salaries and other benefits and generally to exercise all powers ancillary and incidental to effectively carry out the objects of the Trust.
- L. The Board shall have power to make and rescind rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust.
- M. No Trustee shall commit any act or breach of Trust of the Trust fund or property or cause any loss to the Trust

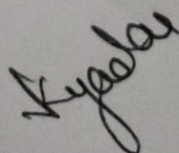
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property or commit fraud in the administration of the Trust fund / property.

N. The Trustees shall be entitled to any Salary, allowances or perquisites, if the board of trustee with a special resolution passes a resolution to the affect and except to this they shall also be entitled to reimbursement of actual expenses incurred in connection with attending to the Trust matters.

O. The Board of Trustees will follow the instructions given by any donor who makes substantial contribution towards furtherance of the objects of the Trust, so long as such instructions are not detrimental to the attainment of the objects of the Trust and are in conformity with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961.

P. Power to make members- Every person inspired by the function and social works of the trust or every person who is willing to be engaged in or who may help in furtherance of or contribute to attaining the aims/objects of the Trust may be invited by the Trust to become a member of the trust, after payment of the membership fees, which shall be decided by the board of trustees by way of resolution, members shall be selected for their commitment to the objectives of the trust, the person appointed so be called the

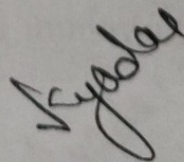


members of the trust, they shall not have the power or status equal to the trustees.

Q. All property of the Trust Movable or Immovable or of any other kind, shall vest in Trust, the Managing Committee shall manage the whole property and affairs of the trust and shall have all powers, duties and functions necessary proper and incidental to the promotion and carrying out of the objects of the trust.

R. In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the Board of Trustees shall for the purposes of this trust shall also have the following powers, duties and functions:

- To acquire by Gift, Grant, Purchase, Exchange, Lease, otherwise, lands, buildings, or other immovable properties and also any Movable Property.
- To construct and maintain buildings, to alter, to demolish or improve them and equip them suitably.
- To accept gifts, donations, endowment and contributions for the Trust and shall be treated as the income of the Trust.

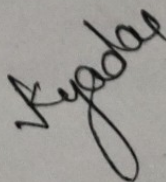


- To raise loans, to receive monies, securities or other movable property on behalf of the Trust.
- To accept any trust, trust fund or endowment so long as the provisions of such Trust or endowment are in consonance with the objects of this Trust.
- To award scholarship and make donations calculated to promote the objects of the Trust.
- To enter into contracts, or engagements on behalf of the Trust.
- To consider such proposals submitted by Sub – committee if may appointed by this trust and allocate such funds if necessary as deemed necessary for the implementation of the programs.
- To make, sign and execute all such documents instruments, as maybe necessary or proper for carrying on the management of the properties and affairs of the Trust.
- To invest such monies and such funds of the trust and to vary the investment as and when it may seem necessary or proper provided that such investments shall be made only upon immovable properties or

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upon securities as the board of trustee may deem fit,
under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.

- To sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of any immovable property of the trust provided all the trustees unanimously resolve that it is in the interest of the trust to do so to sell or lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of any movable and immovable properties of the Trust.
- To appoint such employees on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the work of the trust and exercise control all such employees including the power of suspension, dismissal and removal.
- To delegate to the Managing Trustee or any appointed committee such powers, duties and functions as are vested in the Trustees.
- To frame Bye-Laws and such other regulations as are required for achieving its objectives.
- Out of the income of the trust property the trustee shall be entitled to spend or incur the following expenses namely



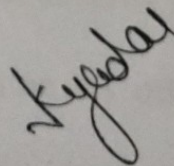
- All rates, taxes, cess, assessments, dues and duties if any payable to the government to any municipal or other public bodies in respect thereof or any part thereof.
- The premium for the insurance of the buildings or any other insurable property movable or immovable for the time being forming part of the trust property.
- The costs of ordinary repairs and for providing any amenities to the buildings for the time being forming part of the trust property.
- cost of making such additions/alterations or improvements to or in the buildings forming part of the trust property, as the trustees shall think fit.
- Wages and salaries of any manager, supervisor, accountant, clerk, servant or other employees employed by the trustees in the carrying out of this trust.
- Cost and expenses of keeping the trust property in good condition.

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- Cost and expenses for installing and renovating the electrical and other installations in the building for the time being forming part of the trust property.
 - The architect's fee and legal charges and fee payable to other professionals engaged in the course of administration of the trust.
 - All other costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the management and administration of the trust property in accordance with the objects and purposes hereof or which may be incidental thereto.
- After deducting the costs charges and expenses incurred by the trustee's as aforesaid out of the total gross income received by them from the trust property the balance that is the net income will be utilized for the objects of the trust as decided by the board of trustees.

S. All the investments shall be made in the name of the trust.

The Trustee or trustees authorized by the board shall execute the necessary documents on behalf of the Trust for such purposes



- T. All the properties of the trust shall be acquired in the name of the trust. Documents pertaining to the same shall be in the name of the trust and shall be executed by such trustee/trustees on behalf of the trust, as may be authorized by the board.
- U. The investments and funds of the trust and the income derived there from shall be applied solely towards the attainment of the objects of the trust.
- V. The trustees shall be entitled to remuneration for services rendered for the trust or its institutions, rent for premises let out, interest on borrowed capital, reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses incurred during the discharge of duties entrusted by the board of trustees, only to the extent in consonance with the provisions of section 13(2) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- W. The board shall have the power to raise loan for the purposes of the Trust and to repay the same from the income or funds of the Trust. The board shall offer such security or guarantee as may be required and resolved by the board and shall also accept the security or guarantee that may be provided by the trustees or any other such persons as may be required and resolved by the Board.

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➤ **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND POWERS:**

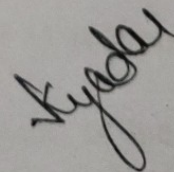
The Roles, Responsibilities and Powers of all these office bearers are defined below. In addition to these, the Board of Trustee may grant additional roles, responsibilities and powers to any of the Trustees as and when required.

A. MANAGING TRUSTEE:

In addition to discharging normal duties of a trustee, the Managing Trustee will be authorized to sign all documents, **including the bank documents**, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, government institutions and other organizations on behalf of the Board of Trustees upon the decision of the Board for each and every case.

The Managing Trustee is authorized to sign bank cheques, deposit into or the withdrawal from the bank and to release vouchers etc.

The Managing Trustee along with the Board of trustees is responsible for ensuring that the Trust pursues its objects and for maintaining the dignity of the Trust organization and shall use his/her influence to promote the activities of the Trust.

A handwritten signature in dark ink, appearing to be 'Kyaba', is written over the bottom right portion of the text.

The managing trustee shall sue and be sued on behalf of and against the trust in case any legal action which may occur in future

The managing trustee will prepare Annual Budget, monthly and yearly expenditure statements get the expenditure audited by auditor duly appointed by the Board of Trustees and place them before the Board of Trustees for approval. The managing trustee is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made, receive contributions, sign acknowledgements for the amounts or articles received by the Trust and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before the Board of Trustees for their approval.

The managing trustee is authorized along with the managing trustee to sign bank cheques, application for drafts and payment instructions jointly with the Managing Trustee and draw money from the bank, upto the limits defined by the Board of Trustees in their meetings. The managing trustee is responsible for safe custody of cash, bonds, securities etc. of the Trust.

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B. SECRETARY:

The Secretary shall maintain the records of the organization prepare and circulate agenda and minutes of Board of Trustees meeting.

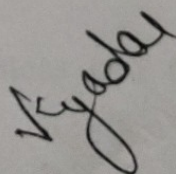
The Secretary shall be also responsible for the day to day administration activities of the Trust. The Secretary shall deal with correspondence received by the Trust, send replies in consultation with the Managing Trustee, and the board of trustees, where necessary. He/she is responsible for the safe custody of all the assets and records of the Trust.

The Secretary shall represent the Trust in all legal matters, sign the papers related to legal cases, attend to courts or represent the Trust in Government offices.

BANK ACCOUNT

3. As also mentioned above The Managing Trustee shall operate Bank Accounts on behalf of the Trust. One or more Bank Accounts may be opened in any Bank and or Banks in the name of the "**Late Sh. Kishori Lal Educational Trust**".

ASSETS AND FUNDS



8. The trustee hereby acknowledges having received, on behalf of trust, the sum of rupees ₹ 21,000/- initially contributing by the author of the trust and the sum or rupees Cash from the each other founder trustees towards the corpus of the trust, and in this way at this time the trust have a total sum of rupees ₹ 21,000/- in his funds/corpus of the trust. And apart from this at present, the Trust has no other property or assets, either movable or immovable, other than the Trust Fund.

ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

9. The financial year of the Trust shall be starts from 1st April from each year, unless otherwise decided by the Board of Trustees. And Proper books of accounts shall be maintained by the Trust regulatory. The books of account shall be closed on 31st March every year. The Board of Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of the Trust.

The trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in the course of the management of trust properties or in relation to carrying out the objects and purposes of the trust as well as of all the assets, liabilities, credits and effects of the trust properties.

The accounts of the Trust shall be annually audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees and the audited

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statement of account shall be placed before the Board for its approval within three months of the close of the financial year.

LIABILITY OF TRUSTEES

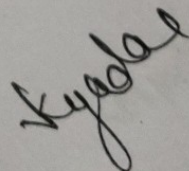
10. The trustees will not be personally liable /responsible for any acts done bonafide of the trust. However the Board of Trustees shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.

The Trust shall not be liable for the acts of the Trustees in their personal capabilities.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

11. The board is hereby authorized to make and prescribe rules, regulations and bye laws for the purpose of management and administration of the Trust and for any of the institutions or activities of the Trust.

The board of trustees may be any supplementary instrument(s) additional rules and bye laws, confer and provide for such powers as

may be required for the purpose of the management and power administration of the trust and its Institutions.

IRREVOCABLE TRUST

12. It is hereby expressly declared that this Trust is a public Charitable Trust and that it is Irrevocable.

AMENDMENTS

13. While this Trust shall be irrevocable, the Board of Trustees may amend any of the clauses except those relating to objects of the Trust. The First Trustees, at a duly convened meeting of the Board with at least 2 weeks' notice, and by a resolution passed by at least three-fourths majority of the Board of Trustees. The amendments to the Trust Deed can only be passed by a resolution of the Board of Trustees in an actual meeting and not by circulation.

If any alteration or amendment is necessary, the same shall be affected through supplementary deed/deeds and which shall be read together with the main Trust deed.

RELATIVES OF THE AUTHOR/SETTLOR AND THE

TRUSTEES

14. Notwithstanding the powers vested with the Trustees under the preceding clause, no part of the income of the Trust shall benefit directly or indirectly the trustees and no part of the income of the

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property of the Trust shall be used or applied directly or indirectly for the benefit of:

- **Author/Settlor, Managing Trustee, Trustees** or any person who makes a substantial contribution to the Trust or of any relative of the **Author/Settlor, Managing Trustee, Trustees** or the person who makes a substantial contribution.
- Any **“related concern”** in which any of the above persons has substantial interest.
- For the purpose of this clause, the word **“relative”** and the phrases **“related concern”**, **“substantial interest”** and **“substantial contribution”** shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT

15. The provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT

16. All clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed of Trust which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be

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deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into force.

DISSOLUTION

17. In the event of dissolution of the Trust, the entire Trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust. The assets left if any, shall be disbursed to any other public Charitable Trust or Trusts or Institution or Institutions having similar objects, as the Board may determine after obtaining approval from the Board and in no event it shall be distributed in any manner, to any of the Board of Trustees or their relatives or related concerns or to the settler/author.

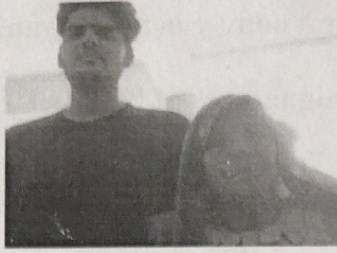
